6	(a) Limitation.—None of the funds appropriated or
7	otherwise available to the Department of Defense may be
8	obligated or expended for United States Armed Forces in
9	support of North Atlantic Treaty Organization Operation
10	Unified Protector with respect to Libya, unless otherwise
11	specifically authorized by law.
12	(b) Exceptions.—The limitation on funds under
13	subsection (a) does not apply with respect to—
14	(1) search and rescue;
15	(2) intelligence, surveillance, and reconnais-
16	sance;
17	(3) aerial refueling; and
18	(4) operational planning.
