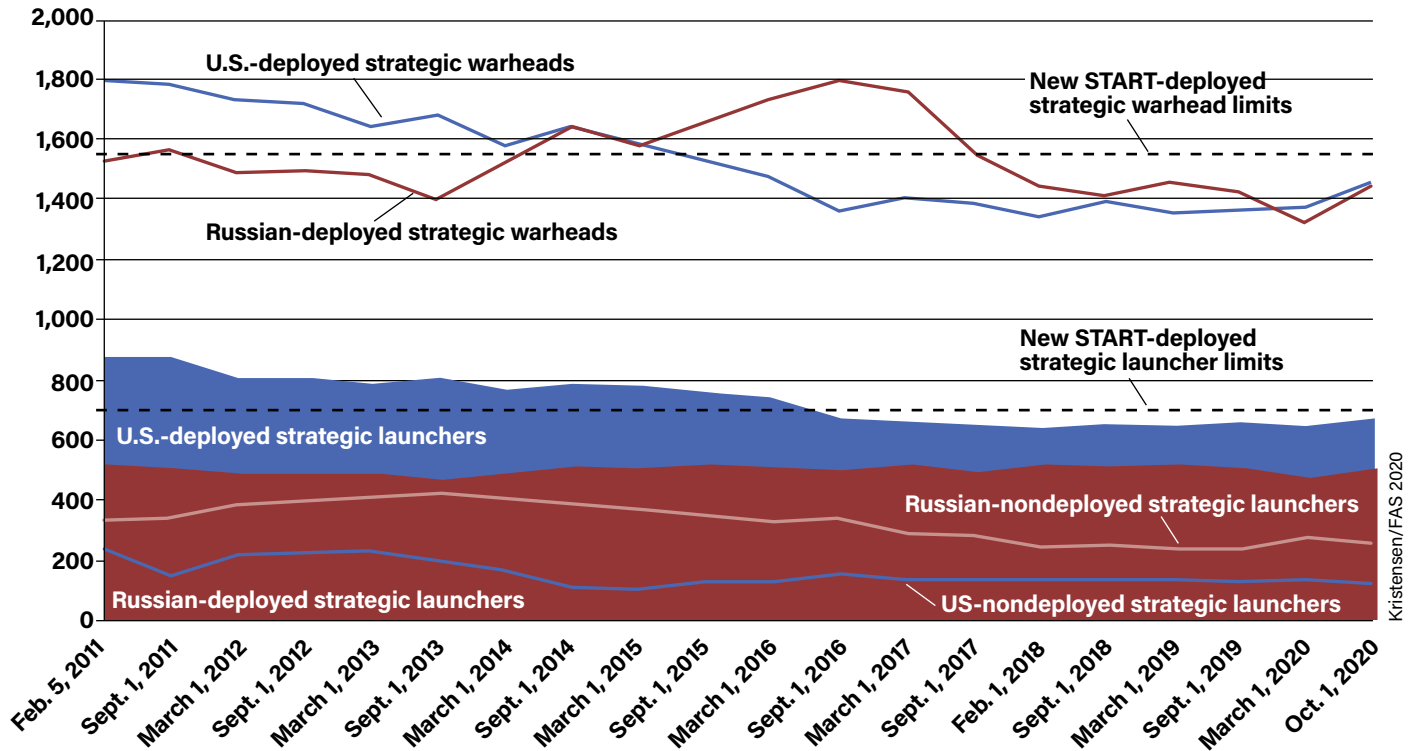


Strategic Nuclear Forces Under New START

The New START went into effect Feb. 5, 2011, and in the decade since, both the U.S. and Russia reduced the number of strategic launchers at their disposal, holding the totals for launchers and warheads beneath the treaty's maximum. Here's how the totals have changed in that time:
